



General Winter Water Park Rules:

- No one allowed when lifeguard not on duty.
- Only paying patrons or season pass holders allowed inside the facility.
- No refunds will be provided for any reasons!
- Children age 10 and under must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older) at all times.
- Parents are expected to supervise their children and assist in enforcing the policies for the safety and enjoyment of all patrons.
- All swimmers must wear a swimsuit. No cutoff jeans, street clothes, thongs or extremely revealing swimwear.
- Clean, solid color t-shirts only to be worn in the water for protection of the sun.
- No outside food, snacks or drinks allowed to be brought into the facility.
- Concession stand food and drinks will only be allowed in the concession area. Sunbathers may have water on the deck.
- Trashcans are provided and patrons are expected to dispose of their own trash.
- No one with casts, open wounds, rash, infectious, or communicable diseases will be admitted.
- No smoking, vaping, chewing tobacco or alcohol inside the facility.
- No one under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be admitted.
- No glass containers permitted on grounds.
- No foul language or profanity; will not be tolerated.
- No running, horseplay, shoving or excessive splashing.
- No playing in the shower rooms.
- No lounges, chairs, etc. are to be brought into the facility.
- No pets allowed.
- Service Animals are allowed to accompany the person with a disability, but must stay on the pool deck and CANNOT enter water.
- Only soft/foam type balls allowed.
- Staff reserves the right to deny use of unsafe toys.
- Outside rafts, inner tubes or large floats are not allowed in the facility due to blocking the water surface underneath.
- Facility inner tubes must stay in Lazy River at all times.
- Staff reserves the right to limit the type and size of swim items brought into the facility.
- Children are not allowed to wear personal flotation devices without an adult, 15 years or older, in the water supervising the child. This includes lifejackets, swim rings, armies, etc.
- All persons prone to difficulty controlling their bowels are required to wear a swim diaper.
- During periods of low attendance various attractions may be closed.
- Facility is not responsible for lost, stolen or misplaced items.
- Report all injuries immediately.
- It is the responsibility of the patrons when entering the facility to read and obey all the posted signs.
- Failure to observe these safety precautions may result in dismissal from the facility and premises.
- The Owensville Parks & Recreation Department reserves the right to add additional rules, which may be necessary for the safe operation of the pool.
