Winter Water Park 2020 Modified Operations to Mitigate COVID-19 Risk

Opening Date: Friday, June 5, assuming all modifications can be completed, items purchased/in place and required training is completed.

Modified operations to be continuously reviewed during season and amended when necessary by the City of Owensville at any time. Last reviewed at Board of Alderman (BOA) Meeting on June 15.

Admissions:

- Patrons must maintain proper social distancing while in admission line
- Six-foot spacing marks will be installed for admission line
- Request patrons wear cloth mask or bandanas, covering both nose and mouth (except when in water); to be provided by patrons
- Maximum bather load based on normal facility capacity: June 5-15 25% (95), June 16-30 33% (124), July 33% (124), August/September 50% (188); once maximum is reached then one in, one out
- ~~Limit daily admissions (including special programs) to Gasconade County and Gasconade County R-2 School District residents.~~
 - ~~Parent/guardian will be required to show proof of residency during admission process~~
- As of June 16, facility is open to and welcomes all.
- Daily Waiver/Hold Harmless Form and Log Sheet, updated with COVID-19 risk language and required social distancing must be completed by parent/guardian with requested information and signature.
 - All children 11-17 must be accompanied by an adult (18 or older) to admission window to answer questions and sign daily waiver/log sheet for minors
 - All children 10 & under must be supervised by an adult (18 or older) at all times while in the facility, per original facility rules

- Front desk attendant will ask the following questions to each adult:

Have you had any of the following signs or symptoms within the last 72 hours:

- Temperature is or has been greater than 100.4-degree Fahrenheit?
- Coughing?
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing?
- Chills?
- Repeated shaking with chills?
- Muscle pain?
- Headache?
- Sore throat?
- New loss of taste or smell?
- Close contact with person with any of the above symptoms or known COVID-19?

No person shall be permitted entry if any of the above symptoms were present within the last 72 hours

- Utilize daily admission and value cards this season
 - No season pass sales will be offered
- ~~Daycares to maintain a maximum 1:3 ratio for supervisors to children~~
- As of June 16, daycares must follow state mandated ratio for supervisors to children

Concessions:

- Patrons must maintain proper social distancing while in concession line
- Six-foot spacing marks will be installed for concession line
- Utilizing bottle beverages only (no fountain or slushy)
- Utilizing individual portioned tortilla chips
- Minimize food options
- Concession attendant will provide condiments and not have common container patrons touch
- Reduced seating to 4 tables

Daily Operations:

- Patrons must maintain proper social distancing while on pool deck and in water
- Pool breaks will be eliminated to minimize crowding on pool deck and concession stand at any one time
- Guards rotating off stand will spray common items that are touched regularly by staff and public.

Pool Deck:

- Six-foot spacing marks will be installed on pool deck
- Plastic deck furniture will be removed
 - Patrons will be allowed to bring own foldable lawn chair or camping chair
- Concrete tables/benches will be removed
- Wooden benches will be removed
- Basketball hoop will be removed
- ~~Toddler swings will be removed~~
- As of June 16, toddler swings will return.
- Maximum number of tubes/patrons in lazy river: 20

Locker Rooms:

- Maximum number of patrons in each locker room at one time: 5
- Locker bins will be removed
- Any furniture not permanently installed to the ground will be removed

Programming:

- Swim lessons will not be held
- Water Aerobics to be held (with delayed start of June 30) while maintaining social distancing and a maximum of 20 participants per class
- Special Programs (Adult River Walk, Tot Splash and Lap Swim) to be held (with delayed start of June 8) while maintaining proper social distancing and with maximum participants each session: 30
- All previous listed provisions will also apply to special programs

Private Rentals:

- Social distancing and COVID-19 screening questions to guests will be the responsibility of renter
- Updated rental document will include COVID-19 risk language and required proper social distancing
- Maximum party capacity, based on normal facility capacity: June 5-15 25% (95), June 16-30 33% (124), July 33% (124), August/September 50% (188)
- All previous listed provisions will also apply to rentals
